


Supply list for first grade

Here are the school supplies your child will need on the first day of school in September.

1 marble notebook to be used as a homework assignment pad

1 box any size crayons

1 box washable markers

1 box colored pencils

1 box watercolor paints

2 packs assorted color construction paper

1 bottle of liquid paste and 1 large glue stick (no gel glue)

1 pair scissors

1 large pink eraser

1 clear plastic shoebox, labeled with child's name

2 two-pocket folders with the pocket across the bottom

1 container of Lysol wipes or 1 bottle of hand gel

2 boxes of tissues

1 box of baby wipes

4 sharpened pencils (regular size)

1 roll of paper towels
